## **TECH TIPS - Is your Horn working properly?**

### **WE CAN LEARN FROM GEESE**

As each bird flaps its wings it creates uplift for the bird following. By flying in a "V" formation, the whole flock adds 71% greater flying range than if a bird flew alone.

Whenever a goose falls out of formation and suddenly feels a drain and resistance of trying to fly alone it quickly gets back into formation and takes advantage of the lifting power of the bird immediately in front.

When the lead goose gets tired it rotates back to the formation and another flies at the point position, these geese in formation honk from behind to encourage those up front to keep up their speed.

When a goose gets sick or wounded or shot down two geese drop out of formation and follow it down to help protect it, they stay until it is able to fly again or dies then they launch out on their own with another formation or catch up with the flock.

**Lesson:** *If we have as much sense as geese we too will stand by each other in difficult times as well as when we are strongest supporting one another and watching out for each other.*
