TECH TIPS:

Break pads. My goodness, haven’t I had some fun changing my front and rear break pads recently? You can buy two different types - carbon with metal usually by CBC or Genuine, then you can get ceramic with heat shields. Which ones are the best, I have got both, and the single disk on the rear with the carbon/metal CBC breaks pull me up better than the ceramic twin disks on the front (*only because I forgot to rough them up first like ya supposed to*), you choose what you want, the ceramic are cheaper and if you sand them first they work better.

After removing your old breaks, it is relatively simple to use a screw driver in the centre of the brake piston to push it back in, but pressure builds up in your reservoir and stops you, so take the top off and release the pressure, but don’t do what I did and leave it off, as I ended up with break fluid all over my bike, which works like paint stripper, thankfully I was quick enough with water and a wash to get it all of without damage to the paint work.

Don’t forget - It is a good idea to give your new pads a light rub with a coarse sand paper before putting them in, it just helps them “bed in”. Once finished, pump the handle numerous times, check your fluid is high and then go for a slow ride, while riding hold the break on for a couple of seconds under throttle to keep moving and then release it, do this maybe half a dozen times, this will also help the bedding in process and you should find they work rather well.
